Joshua H. Before that, Mr. Juel worked in the cruise line industry in positions of increasing responsibility, shipboard and shoreside, the most recent of which was with Norwegian Cruise Line (NCL) as a Human Resources Director.

Mr. Juel holds degrees from the Great Lakes Maritime Academy and Cornell University. He also earned his license as a U.S. Merchant Marine deck officer for vessels of unlimited tonnage, in addition to marine pilotage from Duluth, Minnesota to Cape Vincent, New York.
